



"The attitude of the population of the Kyrgyz Republic towards the gender quota in local keneshes"

Results of a sociological survey commissioned by the Central Commission for Elections and Referendums of the Kyrgyz Republic

October 11, 2024, "Ball room", hotel "Sheraton"

PREREQUISITES

At the request of the Central Commission for Elections and Referendums of the Kyrgyz Republic, a sociological survey was conducted during the summer of 2024, one of the goals of which was to assess the attitude of the population of the Kyrgyz Republic towards the gender quota applied in the process of elections to local keneshes. The survey showed that about 80% of citizens of Kyrgyzstan support the gender quota in local keneshes, but extreme differences are noted across districts. The difference in positions regarding the quota is not related to the quality of work of female deputies, which the majority of citizens rated as "excellent". The conditions for expanding women's political leadership depend on the family, and most families in Kyrgyzstan build relationships between genders on the foundations inherited from their ancestors, therefore, in certain territories, the status of "kelin" affects women's opportunities to expand political rights.

Government can make a difference by helping to improve the conditions for women's political empowerment, and activists and civil society must use an effective entry point to support women through widespread recognition of their economic and social contributions to development.

The survey was conducted by the Development Policy Institute on behalf of the Partnership for the Local Self-governance Development in the Kyrgyz Republic. The total number of respondents was 2,637 people, including 1,660 women and 977 men. Field data collection was carried out by the Erfolg Consult company.
